

Food Importation Compliance Procedure



Administrative department

Penalty

According to Food Safety Law, once found that imported food does not comply with the national food safety standards or there is evidence that such imported food may endanger human health, the importer shall immediately stop trading and recall products. A fine of between RMB 50,000 and RMB 100,000 shall also be imposed, in cases where the total value of illegal food products and/or food additives involved is less than RMB 10,000; otherwise, the fine shall be up to twenty times—but not less than ten times—of the total value of illegal food products and/or food additives involved.

Ingredients compliance review

- Purpose: Report whether product (ingredients and additives) comply with Chinese regulations
- Main content:
- 1) Confirm with client whether or not the product can be imported and if so, identify GB standard
- 2) Review ingredients to identify whether or not the ingredients are compliant.
 3) Offer recommendations to revise product formula for compliance

Chinese food label design

Purpose: verify that the Chinese label of the imported food comply with Chinese regulations Main content:

- 1) Review and revise formula
- 2) Review entire Chinese Label to identify incompliance and advise for compliance.
- 3) Design a fully compliant Chinese label for clients

Custom clearance assistance

Purpose: prepare all the required materials and qualification document Main content: 1) GB testing 2) Exporter filing 3) Food import license 4) Trademark registration service
